This is an informational notice on the status of the Plattsburgh, New York Area Mail Processing (AMP) feasibility study.

On February 10, you were notified of the Postal Service's intent to conduct an AMP study to determine whether efficiency could be increased by consolidating mail processing operations performed at the Plattsburgh, New York Post Office with those performed at the Burlington, Vermont Processing and Distribution Center. While conducting the study, it was determined that there were service issues which could not be reconciled at this time. As a result, the Postal Service decided to halt the study. Should the Postal Service decide to resume this study, you will be notified.
