Provide the names of employees, the gross payment amounts to each employee, the finance number of the employee facility, EIN number, and any other information in fields where data was entered. Please provide the information in electronic format, preferably in an Excel friendly format.
2. Identify the individuals that entered the data into GATS and/or any other programs that were then used to pay employees per the 1.6b award, by name, title, finance number, and work location. If the work was outsourced, in addition to the employee information, provide the name of the organization(s) that the work was outsourced to and the name and title of the contact person of the organization(s).
3. Identify the USPS management official responsible for ensuring that the final payouts to employees matched the data provided by the union in regards to the names of employees and their share of the remedy.
