The APWU proudly presents the winners of three scholarship programs: the E.C. Hallbeck Memorial Scholarship, Vocational Scholarship, and Best Essay Award for 2015.

Hallbeck winners will receive a \$2,000 award each year for a period of four years to be used in an undergraduate program. The Vocational Scholarship winners will receive up to \$3,000 to be used for three years of study in a trade, technical, industrial or vocational school. The Best Essay winner will receive a one-time award of \$2,000.

Winners are selected from applicants who are the children or grandchildren of current, retired or deceased APWU members.

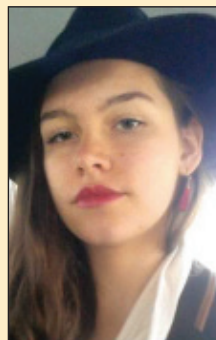
Union Plus Scholarship Winners

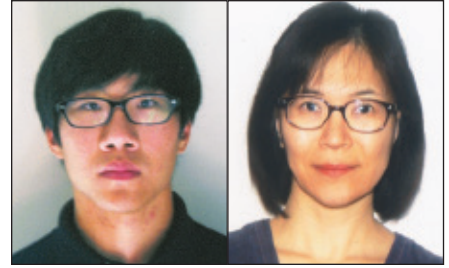

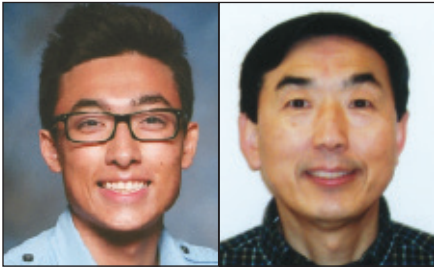
