SUBJECT: Request - Withholding Moore SC, Clerk (Event # 58777)

Due a function 4 Customer Service Variance review, it is anticipated that 1 Level PS-6 PTF clerk will be reassigned outside of the Craft and/or Installation at the Moore Post Office.

To minimize dislocation and inconvenience of regular work force employees consistent with the needs of the service, it is requested that full-time and part-time residual duty assignments be withheld.

Specifically, it is recommended that 1 Level PS-6 clerk full-time and part-time assignments within a 50 mile radius be withheld.


