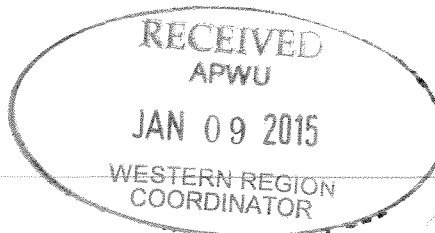

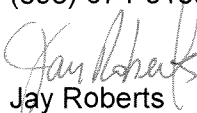
This is to advise you of the intent of the Sacramento District to utilize the provisions of Article 12.5.C.5 of the National Agreement to involuntarily reassign seven (7) full-time clerks from the craft and/or installation at the Sacramento bid installation (Event 49177). This impact is based on a 24 hour clock Function 1 baseline.

The impacted employees will be notified of their involuntary reassignments by separate letter.

By copy of this notice, we will withhold seven (7) full-time assignments in the clerk, carrier, mail handler and/or custodial crafts in sites within a 50 mile radius of the impacted bid cluster.

Attached you will find copies of the automated impact statement, the operational data that supports the excessing, the list of sites at which withholding has been authorized and the names of the junior impacted employees.
