On November 19, 1981, you met with Frank Dyer in pre-arbitration discussion of H8C-5D-C-11000. After a thorough discussion of the issue, it was mutually agreed that the following would represent a full settlement of the case.

- 1. An employee may be required to report an accident on the day it occurs; however, completion of the appropriate forms will be in accordance with applicable rules and regulations and need not be on the day of the accident.
- 2. Any corrective action that may be initiated for failure to properly report an accident will have to stand the test of just cause on a case by case,
