Dear Mr. Overby:

On August 7, 1981, you met with Frank Dyer in pre-arbitration discussion of H8N-5L-C-11249. After a thorough discussion of the issue, it was mutually agreed that the following would represent a full settlement of the case:

- An employee may be required to report an accident on the 1. day it occurs; however, completion of the appropriate forms will be in accordance with applicable rules and regulations and need not be on the day of the accident.
- 2. Any corrective action that may be initiated for failure to properly report an accident will have to stand the test of just cause on a case by case basis.

Please sign the attached copy of this letter acknowledging your agreement with this settlement, withdrawing H8N-5L-C-11249 from the pending national arbitration listing.
