Dear Mr. Thompson:

On June 18, 1991, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management violated the National Agreement when it used a locally developed form.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. We also agreed that the issuance of local forms and the local revision of existing forms is governed by Section 324.12 of the Administrative Support Manual.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration if necessary.
