On April 16, 1986, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether the union was improperly denied a copy of an employee's performance evaluation.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. We agreed that the question raised requires application of the provisions of Administrative Support Manual, Appendix B, Section 120.153.5 to the facts involved.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing as stated above.
