Dear Mr. Lingberg:

On October 14, 1987, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is ~~whether local management~~ properly applied the provisions of Part 350 of the Administrative Support Manual in citing the grievant's past safety record.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. Whether local management properly applied the provisions of Part 350 of the Administrative Support Manual in citing the grievant's past safety record can only be determined by evaluation of the fact circumstances.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration if necessary.
