Dear Mr. Wilson:

On January 26, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

The issue in this grievance is whether a MPLSM clerk can be instructed to weigh mail from the error and/or misfaced bins as an allied machine duty.

After further review of the matter, we mutually agreed the disputed duties could be considered allied machine duties and could be assigned to a MPLSM crew member.
