

Dear Mr. Wilson:

On several dates beginning November 3, 1982, we discussed the grievances on the attached listing at the fourth step of our ntractual grievance procedure.

The issue raised in the cases involved whether the grievants are entitled to environmental differentials set forth in Federal Personnel Manual Supplemental 532-1, Appendix J, that are paid to employees who are exposed to various hazards. The grievants contend that they were exposed to several environmental contaminents while working at the Biscayne Annex in Miami.

During our discussions, we agreed that postal employees are not covered by the aforementioned provisions. We also agreed to consider the matter closed.
