On November 16, 1982, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure. 31100

This grievance involves denial of the grievant's request for revised schedule to allow her to observe a religious day on une 19, 1982.

According to the step 2 decision, the grievant had been accommodated on practically every Saturday over a period of several months; however, due to changes, leave commitments, and other needs she could no longer be accommodated. The step 2 decision also states that she will be scheduled off on Saturdays whenever it does not adversely impact upon the needs of the service.
