

ear Mr. Wilson:

on July 26, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned rievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure. The grievance had been discussed previously.

The question raised in this grievance is whether management violated provisions of the National Agreement in not awarding the grievant the assignment with which this grievance is concerned.

After further review of this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. Whether the decision, that the grievant was not qualified to perform the duties of the assignment in question, was proper will turn on the fact circumstances in this particular case.

Accordingly, as further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to Step 3 for further processing if necessary by the parties no contractual vio. sign. Local managinest deteinined L. level tant ta
