On September 30, 1987, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether Article 1, Section 6, was violated when the Data Collection Office performed ODIS and RPW tests.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. The Standard Position Description of the Data Collection Office is clear in outlining duties and responsibilities.
