

On December 21, 1978, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

We wish to reaffirm our position that supervisors will perform bargaining unit work only in accordance with the provisions of Article I, Section 6 of the National Agreement. Therefore, the supervisor will not place mail on the distribution case ledges. Under the circumstances, we consider the case closed.
