

Dear Mr. Thompson:

On May 7, 1991, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management violated Article 1.6 of the National Agreement by obtaining reports from the Electronic Time Clock (ETC) System.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretative issue is fairly presented in this case. We also mutually agreed that National Award AC-N-6922 should be applied to the fact circumstances.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration if necessary.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand this case.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
