Dear Mr. Anderson:

On January 23, 1985, we met to discuss the above-captioned case at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure set forth in the 1981 National Agreement.

The question raised in this grievance involved whether PTF carriers are being employed in lieu of PTF clerks.

After further review of this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in the particulars evidenced in this case. Whether the subject carriers are being employed in lieu of clerks is a matter for regional determination and is not an interpretive question.

Accordingly, as we further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, if necessary.
