

Dear Mr. Adams:

On January 20, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The question raised in this grievance is whether employees: who stayed beyond their tour or who came in on their non-scheduled day to take a TB test are entitled to out-of-scheduled pay.

During our discussion, we agreed that under the circumstances described in this case, only employees who took the test during their regularly scheduled workday were entitled to take it on-the-clock on a no-loss-no-gain basis.

Accordingly, we agreed to close the case based on a finding 1 of no contractual violation.
