Dear Mr. Wilson:

On October 1, you met with Frank Dyer in pre-arbitration discussion of H1C-2F-C 894, Reading, PA. The question in this grievance is whether management violated Article 8 by not paying the grievants for time spent traveling from their home office to the MSC for training. The Union also feels that two of the grievants should be paid for waiting on another employee to complete his training.

After a discussion of the issues it was mutually agreed to full settlement of the case as follows:

The two employees who were required by the Postal Service to wait until another employee completed his training will be compensated for the waiting period.

Please sign the copy of this letter acknowledging your agreement, withdrawing B1C-2F-C 894 from the national arbitration listing.
