On December 16, 1982, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The question raised in this grievance involved whether four employees at the Terre Haute Post Office were entitled to out-of-schedule overtime pay for hours worked outside of their original bid-assignment.

During our discussion, we agreed that under the provisions of article 8.4, the employees are entitled to compensation for time worked in the temporary schedule. We also agreed to remand the case to step 3 for appropriate action and resolution.
