Dear Mr. Baldwin:

On January 13, 1981, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

We mutually agreed that the employees in this case were not assigned to permanent new reporting hours immediately after their jobs were abolished. On September 6, 1980, they were detailed from what was considered by management as their normal reporting time of 6:00 a.m. to new hours of 9:30 a.m. Not until September 20, 1980, were they permanently reassigned to new hours. They shall receive out-of-schedule premium for the hours worked outside of their regular tour.

Please sign the attached copy of this decision as your acknowledgment of agreement to resolve this grievance.
