January 29, 1975, we met with you to discuss the above-mentioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

Matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

Grievance requests eight hours pay for three (3) employees called in to work on their day off in the Dothan Office. The facts reveal that each of the said employees was allowed to go home after four hours work, for reasons deemed acceptable to management. The employees stated their requests on Form 3971. Under such circumstances, the employees were properly paid for the hours worked. Therefore, the grievance is denied.
