Dear Mr. Connors:

On June 17 we met in prearbitration discussion of H1C-1E-C 24150, GMF, Boston, Massachusetts. The question in this grievance is whether the grievant is entitled to higher level pay while in a leave status on the dates he normally would be performing higher level work as required by his bid position.

It was mutually agreed to full settlement based on the particulars of this case as follows:

1. The grievant will be paid for those days where his bid required him to be on a higher level status and he was on leave.
2. Backpay will be computed beginning 14 days prior to the date of the Step 1 grievance.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter acknowledging your agreement to settle this case, withdrawing H1C-1E-C 24150 from the national pending arbitration listing.
