Dear Mr. Anderson:

On March 25, 1980, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

In this grievance, a supervisor returned to the clerk craft after an absence of more than 2 years. He was given a new seniority date and placed in a full-time regular clerk position. The Union alleges that he should have been placed in a part-time flexible position.

It is our position that no contractual provision or regulation precludes management from placing an employee in a full-time craft assignment under the above circumstances. Management's obligations as per Article 12, Section 2.8.2 were fully met with the establishment of the new seniority date. No other obligation exists. Accordingly, this grievance is denied.
