On May 28, 1987, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether installation of fire doors created a safety hazard.


After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. This is a local dispute suitable for regional determination by application of Article 14 of the National Agreement to the fact circumstances involved.


Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration if necessary.
