Dear Mr. Anderson:


Recently, you met with Frank Dyer in pre-arbitration discussion of H8C-5K-C 12734, Las Vegas, NV. The question in this grievance is whether management violated the National Agreement when management refused to pay some employees in this local office administrative leave when they went home because there was no water at their facility for approximately 5 hours.

It was mutually agreed to full settlement of this case as follows:

The situation that brought rise to this grievance is now moot. However, should it arise again management should make every effort to provide employees with drinking water and comfort relief facilities.

Please sign the attached copy of this letter acknowledging your agreement with this settlement, withdrawing H8C-5K-C 12734 from the pending national arbitration listing.
