Dear Mr. Wilson:

On January 3, 1983, we met on the above-captioned case at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure set forth in the 1981 National Agreement.

The question raised in this grievance is whether or not a step 1 resolution violated provisions of a local memorandum of understanding.

After further review of this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in the particulars evidenced in this case. Whether or not provisions of the local memorandum of understanding were followed in reaching the step 1 resolution is not a national interpretive issue.

Accordingly, as we further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to the parties at step 3 for further processing if necessary.
