Dear Mr. Wilson:

On July 26, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

This grievance concerns whether a record of discussion documented on Form 1769 must be destroyed pursuant to instructions in the Administrative Support Manual, Appendix B, USPS 120.190. The 1769's are over 3 years old.

It is the position of the Postal Service that the retention requirements of Appendix B, USPS 120.190, are not applicable to employee accident records such as the Form 1769, Accident Report. This form is maintained in accordance with the requirements of Appendix B, USPS 120.035. The record is maintained locally for two years. Copies are maintained at National Headquarters for five years following the end of the calendar year to which they relate as required by OSHA.

It appears that an application of the above would resolve this grievant's concerns.
