On January 7, 1987, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is did management violate the 1984 National Agreement by denying the union requested information.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed that under Article 31, Section 2, of the National Agreement, request for information pertaining to purely local matters should be submitted by local union representative to the installation head.

If relevancy can be established, pursuant to the provisions of Article 31, then management will provide such information to the union.

It is our position if a search must be performed by professional or managerial personnel there will be a fee.
