## Re: Annual Leave Exchange for Leave Year 2024

The parties agree that Information Technology/Accounting Services career employees will be allowed to sell back a maximum of eighty (80) hours of annual leave prior to the beginning of leave year 2024 provided the following two (2) criteria are met:

- 1. The employee must be at the maximum leave carryover ceiling at the start of the leave year, and
- 2. The employee must have used fewer than 75 sick leave hours in leave year 2023.

In all other respects, the provisions of the Annual Leave Exchange program will remain unchanged.
