Re: Annual Leave Exchange for Leave Year 2025

The parties agree that Information Technology/Accounting Services career employees will be allowed to sell back a maximum of eighty (80) hours of annual leave prior to the beginning of leave year 2025 provided the following two (2) criteria are met:

- 1. The employee must be at the maximum leave carryover ceiling at the start of the leave year, and
- 2. The employee must have used fewer than 75 sick leave hours in leave year 2024.

In all other respects, the provisions of the Annual Leave Exchange program will remain unchanged.

This MOU will expire with the conclusion of the 2025 leave year.
