Dear Mr. Wilson:

On December 21, 1982, you met with Frank Dyer in pre-arbitration discussion of H8C-5K-C 12566. The question in this grievance is whether management violated the National Agreement by allowing employees who voluntarily bid 1 hour of training time for every 16 scheme items rather than 90 days.

It was mutually agreed to full settlement of this case as follows:

1. Employees will be assigned 1 hour of training time for every 16 scheme items.
2. In addition to the qualification examination at the end of the employee's 90-day deferment period, upon request the senior bidder will be allowed no more than 2 early attempts to qualify.

Please sign the enclosed copy of this letter acknowledging your agreement with this settlement, withdrawing H8C-5K-C 12566 from the pending national arbitration listing.
