Dear Mr. Tunstall:

On July 2, 1987, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management's failure to provide off-the-clock manual scheme training to the grievant prior to her begin tour violated the National Agreement.

During our discussion, it was mutually agreed that the following constitutes full settlement of this grievance.

> Senior bidders who elect training hours outof-schedule have the option to train only on scheduled workdays either immediately before or imm diately after regular work hours.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to settle this case.
