Dear Mr. Tunstall:

On July 27, 1989, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management is required schedule employees for scheme training five days per k during the deferment period.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. The PO-402T (1981 issue which is still in effect), part 133.4 states:

"Scheme training should be scheduled each day the trainee is scheduled for work."

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration if necessary.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand this case.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
