On August 11, 1983, we discussed the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The question raised in this case is whether management is quired to post a notice designating the successful bidder at the end of the 90-day deferment period, specified in Article 37.3:F.3.

During our discussion, we agreed to close this case based on our mutual understanding that there is no requirement under Article 37.3.F.3 to post a notice of successful bidder at the end of the 90-day period. We also agreed that while there is no contractual obligation to post such a notice, there is no prohibition.
