On March 5, 1990, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether using Postal Service Test O/N-400 for selection to the Small Parcel/Bundle Sorter Operator position violates the National Agreement.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed that this issue has been resolved with the following:

1. Postal Service test O/N 400 is the appropriate exam for new employees entering the Postal Service for all machine positions.
2. However, for bidding purposes only, Tests O/N 400 and O/N 440 are interchangeable.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this decision as your acknowledgment of agreement to settle this case.
