Dear Mr. Tunstall:

On November 10, 1986, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management violated the National Agreement by not awarding job 810-7 to the grievant and whether the touch calculator test is an essential requirement for the job in question.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issues are fairly presented in this case. This is a local dispute suitable for regional determination based upon the particular circumstances.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration if necessary.
