

Dear Mr. Wilson:

Cn May 11, 1984, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievances at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

These grievances involve the posting and award of Procurement Clerk, Level-5, vacancies at the Flushing Post Office.

During our discussion, we agreed to the following:

- In filling the positions in question, the provisions of Articles 37.3.A.l and 37.3.F.5 are to be followed.
- EL-303, Section 174, relative to the use of PS Form 1717 for senior-qualified bids, applies to this case.
- 3. Heavy lifting can be specified on a job posting if it is a physical requirement unusual to the specific assignment.

We also agreed that these cases require application of the above, rather than an interpretation. Accordingly, as agreed, the cases are hereby remanded to Step 3 for application of the foregoing to the fact circumstances.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this decision as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand these cases.
