On November 1, 1982, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

We mutually agreed to resolve all issues involved in this grievance based upon our understanding that when a posted duty assignment requires a specific skill(s) where the employee must be immediately qualified, the senior bidder will be given an opportunity to demonstrate the skill(s). This includes typing if the senior bidder is not already on a locally maintained typing register.
