

Dear Mr. Wilson:

On January 13, 1984, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The grievance concerns whether management may establish a typing requirement for bulk mail clerk positions.

We mutually agreed that this grievance does not fairly present a nationally interpretive issue. Article 37, Section 3.F., provides sufficient guidance for dealing with this dispute.

Accordingly, this grievance is remanded to Step 3 for appropriate application.
