Dear Mr. Tunstall:

On September 30, 1986, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is the deferment period for window training.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. We further agree that the deferment period (nonscheme) as cited in Article 37, Section 3(F)(7), begins upon commencement of training and ends when the results of the qualification procedures are announced.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration if necessary.
