On February 12, 1982, you met with Margaret Oliver for a pre-arbitration discussion of the above-referenced case.

The issue raised in this case involved the establishment of a Postage-Due Technician position at the Denver, Colorado Post Office.

During the discussion, it was mutually agreed that a National interpretative question was not fairly presented in the particulars evidenced in the case. Whether or not the Denver Post Office qualifies for a Postage-Due Technician position is a matter that has to be determined by an evaluation of the fact circumstances involved.
