

Dear Mr. Baldwin:

On October 20, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievnce at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The grievance concerns the grievant's contention that she has been performing the duties of a Postage Due Technician for over two years. She requests that her present job be upgraded to level 6 and that she be paid back pay for the past two years.

We mutually agreed that no interpretive issue is involved in this case.

The Postage Due Technician, Level 6, position is authorized where the scope of daily postage due activity requires that the employee spend at least 75% of the time on the basic functions, and involves a minimum of 40 trust fund accounts with yearly revenue in excess of 1355 revenue units.

Whether or not a Postage Due Technician position is justified in this local office can only be determined by review of the fact circumstances as they exist at the local level. Accordingly, this grievance is remanded to Step 3 for appropriate handling. Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this decision as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand this case.
