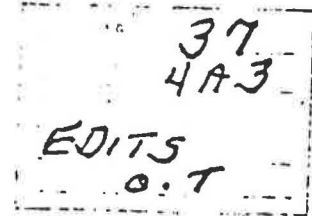

Dear Mr. Tunstall:

On July 12, 1985, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether EDITS were properly performed and included in the grievant's Individual Performance Record.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. This is a local dispute suitable for regional determination by application of Article 37, Section 4A(3) to the fact circumstances. Management is not precluded from running EDITS while employees are working in an overtime status.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing including arbitration, if necessary.
