Recently, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance involves rotation systems on the Single Position High Speed Induction Unit (SPHSIU).


After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. We further agreed that this matter can be resolved by application of the memorandum of understanding between the United States Postal Service and American Postal Workers Union, AFL-CIO, regarding Single Position High Speed Induction Unit (SPHSIU), dated September 28, 1990 (copy attached).


Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing (including arbitration if necessary).
