Dear Mr. Baldwin:

On November 8, 1982, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

The question in this grievance is whether management violated Article 37 of the national agreement by allegedly displacing the grievant from his bid assignment with an employee, from an overlapping tour, who had an identical bid assignment.

According to the information provided, displacement did not occur in this instance. Both employees worked within their bid assignments.

As we find no contractual violation, the grievance is denied.
