

On December 10, 1984, we met to discuss the above-captioned case at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure set forth in the National Agreement.

The question raised in this grievance involved the use of part-time regulars in pool and relief assignments.

After further review of this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in the particulars evidenced in this case. Therefore, this grievance is remanded with the following understanding:

Postal Relief and Pool Assignments are to be filled by Full-Time Regular employees. Accordingly, this grievance is remanded for application and specific circumstances unique to this case.
