This supersedes my April 12 letter to you regarding the above-captioned case.

On April 1, 1985, and again on April 23, we discussed the above-captioned case at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.


The issue in this grievance is whether the position of Accounting Clerk should have been awarded to the senior bidder or senior qualified bidder.

After further review of this matter, we mutually agreed that there was no national interpretive issue fairly presented in this case. This is a local dispute suitable for regional determination by application of Part 525.1 of the Personnel Operations Handbook, P-11, and Article 37, Section 3.F.(5).

Accordingly, as we further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to Step 3 for further consideration by the parties.
