

Dear Mr. Wilson:

November 10, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned revance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The question in this grievance is whether management violated Article 37 of the National Agreement by not awarding the grievant a Bulk Mail Clerk assignment.

In this case, the grievant failed to qualify on training for a position identical to the one which he was denied. The second position became available on the day that he failed to qualify.

Considering the circumstances, we find no contractual general violation and the grievance is denied. To show be wented good
